

MarchingOrder Cookie Policy

We and our service providers use cookies and similar technologies such as local storage (HTML5), web beacons, Javascript, and eTags on our websites. We also allow third parties to use cookies, web beacons, Javascript, and eTag on our website.

What Are Cookies?

Cookies are small text files placed on your computer or device to help the MarchingOrder websites perform efficiently and seamlessly and for certain functions. Cookies are unique to your account, your browser, or your device, and are a user's identification card for the MarchingOrder servers. They do not contain names, but contain technical information about your device and/or browser. Every time you go back to the same website, the browser or device sends the cookie file to the website's server. Cookies can be "persistent" or "session" cookies. Cookies cannot access, read, or modify any data on your computer.

How We Use Cookies

We use cookies and similar technologies on our websites, as almost all websites do. We also use cookies when you access some of our products and services. Cookies allow us, among other things, to store your preferences and settings, authenticate and log you in, provide you with a personalized experience, keep our websites secure, and analyze how our websites and online services are performing.

The following table provides information on the types of cookies we use for our websites and products and services.

Type of Cookies Description

Sign-in and authentication	These cookies help us authenticate your MarchingOrder account for the products that you use, keep you signed in, and personalize your use of the MarchingOrder websites and products and services. These cookies may not be disabled and are required for the operation of our MarchingOrder websites and products and services.
Preferences and settings	These cookies help us remember your settings and preferences. We use third-party cookies to help you fill out forms more easily.
Security	MarchingOrder security cookies support the security features of our services and help us detect malicious activities. These cookies may not be disabled and are required for the operation of our MarchingOrder websites and products and services.

Analytics	We use third-party cookies such as Google Analytics and LinkedIn to gather information about website user activities. These analytics cookies help us analyze and improve the performance of the MarchingOrder websites. It also helps us to understand how you use our products and services and what types of devices you use to access them. Third-party analytics cookies may use IP addresses, but are generally not tied to personal information.
Social media features	The MarchingOrder websites include buttons and cookies from Facebook, Twitter, LinkedIn and other social media companies that allow you share content via their services if you are a member and signed in. Any interactions with those features are governed by the privacy and cookie policies of the social media companies. Please consult those privacy and cookie policies to understand how they use your information or to disable cookies that they may set.
Marketing and advertising	These cookies are used to show you ads that are more relevant to you. We may share this information with advertisers or use it to better understand your interests. No student personal data is shared with advertisers. Third-party advertisers and other organizations may use their own cookies to collect information about your activities on our websites and the advertisements you have clicked on. This information may be used by them to serve advertisements that they believe are most likely to be of interest to you based on content you have viewed. Third-party advertisers may also use this information to measure the effectiveness of their advertisements. We do not control these cookies and to disable or reject third-party cookies, please refer to the relevant third party’s website.

We don’t request your consent for cookies that are necessary to display content that you have requested or to provide other function that you have requested while interacting with our site. You can also opt out of third-party cookies from Google Analytics using the Google Analytics opt-out browser setting add-on or third-party ad management tools.

You can always revoke your consent by disabling cookies through your browser. You may change your web browser settings to reject cookies. You should be able to find out how to do this under the “settings” (or “advanced settings”) menu in your browser. If the information is tough to find, try using your favorite search engine to look up how to reject cookies using your particular browser. One tip: If

you set your web browser to reject all third party cookies, the result may be that you can't opt out of some cookies because the opt-out is recorded in a cookie!

Various browsers may offer their own management tool for removing local storage (HTML5).
